Search Design and Judge: Patty Michak

Detective Sniff & Go will be set according to Regulations for AKC Scentwork, Chapter 9 - The Detective Class. Search will consist of 5-10 unknown numbers of hides, 4-6 distractors and in a combined interior + exterior space between 2000-5000 sq ft. You may enter multiple dogs. Dogs should be familiar with all four AKC scentwork odors (birch, anise, clove and cypress) to enter but not required to have a master level title. Warm-up boxes will be available. All runs will be judged and timed as a real trial unless you let the judge know at the start line that you wish to run as FEO. "Qualifying" runs will be ranked and special prizes are available for placements. All teams will be given a map of the search area at the end of their run. Teams will be allowed to continue to search for up to 3 more hides after false alert if the handler wishes to do so. Handlers are encouraged to film their runs and bring spectators.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Dogs that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

FARM DOG CERTIFICATE

The AKC FDC is open to all dogs **NINE (9) months of age** or older.

AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST

The AKC Temperament Test is open to all dogs **TWELVE (12) months of age or older**

CGC/CGCA/CGCU

The American Kennel Club's (AKC) Canine Good Citizen (CGC) test has no age limit, and is open to both purebred and mixed-breed dogs.

TRICK DOG

The American Kennel Club (AKC) awards the AKC Trick Dog title to dogs that are at least **FOUR (4) months old**.

FITDOG

The American Kennel Club (AKC) awards the AKC Fit Dog title to dogs that are at least **SIX (6) months old**.

Females in season at time of test will not be eligible to run at this event.. Please notify the trial secretary if your dog comes into season as soon as possible by email and you will receive a full refund.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the test grounds. Please help us keep our venue for future events!!

There will be no on-site camping available for this single day event.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Harnesses, and Leashes

Dogs may wear slip collars that are on the dead ring, buckle collars, Martingales and body harnesses in FDC, CGC/CGCA, Trick Dog, and Virtual Rally. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog.

Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric or leather.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, except for Detective sniff & go, and retractable leashes may not be used when on test grounds.. Dogs must enter and exit the test area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting, before and after the test.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical conditions are eligible for a refund with a note from a veterinarian, and/or photo proof of injury.

Females in season will be granted full refund if email/written notice is received by the trial secretary at 8AM on morning of test.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the test area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the test area when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in you will receive your run number. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

Judges **WILL** be flexible with evaluations and accommodate conflicts.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

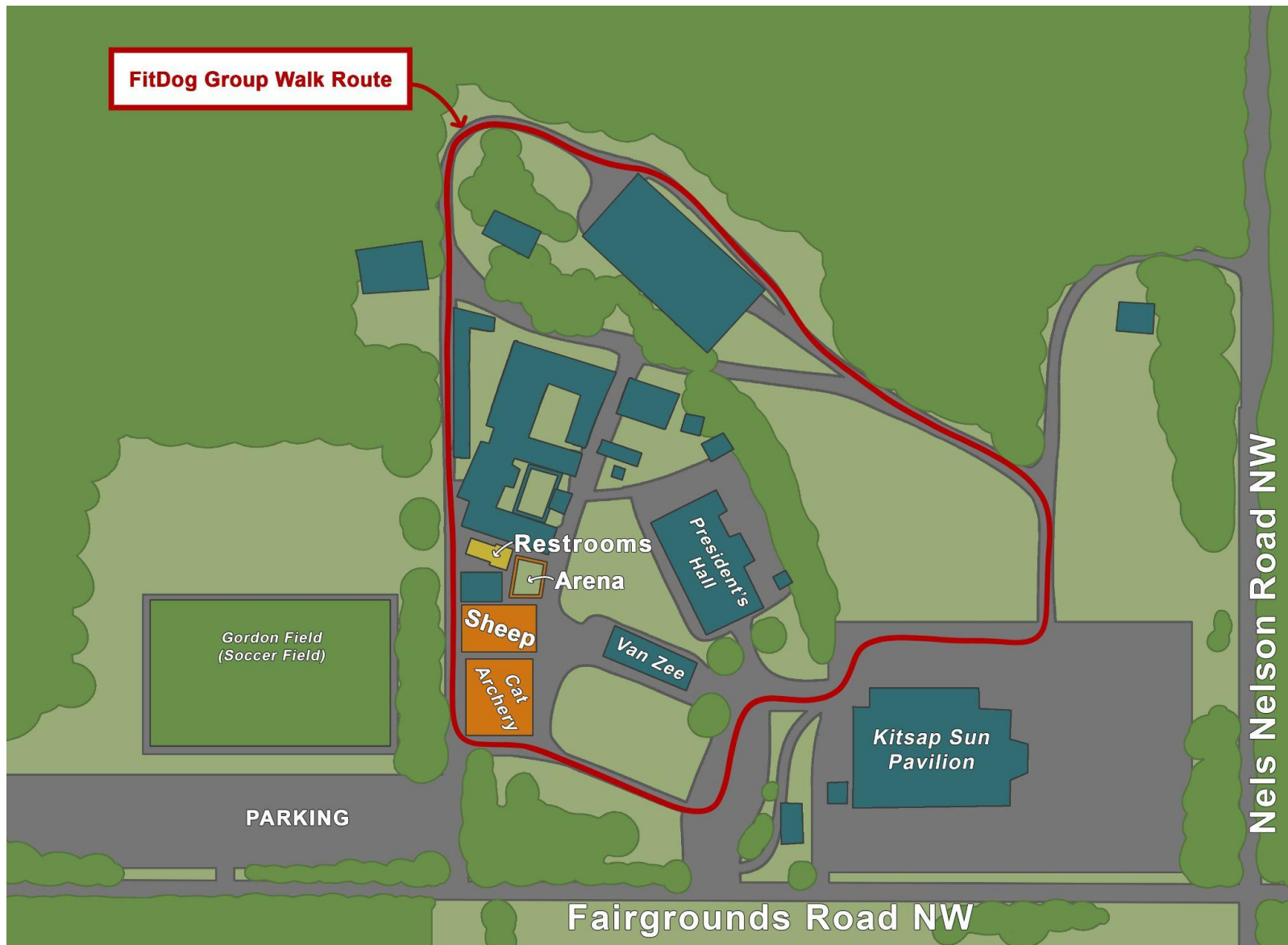
DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From the Bremerton Ferry: Follow the traffic through Kitsap Way. Make a right at the junction of Kitsap Way to Hwy 3 heading north to Silverdale. From WA Hwy 3, take exit 45A to Kitsap Mall Blvd NW. Turn onto Greaves Way, turn right onto Clear Creek Rd NW for approx. 1 mile. Clear Creek Community Center will be on your left

From the Kingston Ferry: Follow traffic onto Highway 104 West. Continue for about 6 miles to a traffic light. Turn right onto Highway 305, follow through next 2 traffic lights and merge onto Highway 3 South. From WA Hwy 3, take exit 45A to Kitsap Mall Blvd NW. Turn onto Greaves Way, turn right onto Clear Creek Rd NW for approx. 1 mile. Clear Creek Community Center will be on your left

From Tacoma: From I-5, take Highway 16 to Gig Harbor/Bremerton. Follow Highway 16 as it becomes Highway 3 towards Silverdale. From WA Hwy 3, take exit 45A to Kitsap Mall Blvd NW. Turn onto Greaves Way, turn right onto Clear Creek Rd NW for approx. 1 mile. Clear Creek Community Center will be on your left.
