**DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

Dogs that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

**AGILITY**

The AKC Virtual Agility program is open to all dogs **FIFTEEN (15) months of age or older**. Dogs cannot have any other agility titles to be eligible for ACT titles.

**VIRTUAL RALLY**

The AKC FDC is open to all dogs **SIX (6) months** of age or older.

**FARM DOG CERTIFICATE**

The AKC FDC is open to all dogs **NINE (9) months of age** or older.

**CGC/CGCA/CGCU**

The American Kennel Club's (AKC) Canine Good Citizen (CGC) test has no age limit, and is open to both purebred and mixed breed dogs.

**TRICK DOG**

The American Kennel Club (AKC) awards the AKC Trick Dog title to dogs that are at least **FOUR (4)** months old.

**FITDOG**

The American Kennel Club (AKC) awards the AKC Fit Dog title to dogs that are at least **SIX (6)** months old.

**Females in season** at time of test will not be eligible to run at this event.. Please notify the trial secretary if your dog comes into season as soon as possible by email and you will receive a full refund.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

**Collars, Harnesses, and Leashes**

Dogs may wear slip collars that are on the dead ring, buckle collars, Martingales and body harnesses in FDC, CGC/CGCA, Trick Dog, and Virtual Rally. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog.

Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric or leather.

Dogs must run Virtual Agility without harnesses. Flat collars may be worn without any hanging attachments.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times, except for inside agility rings, and retractable leashes may not be used when on test grounds.. Dogs must enter and exit the test area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting, before and after the test.

**REFUNDS**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical conditions are eligible for a refund with a note from a veterinarian, and/or photo proof of injury.

Females in season will be granted full refund if email/written notice is received by the trial secretary at 8AM on morning of test.

#### **RINGSIDE**

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the test area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the test area when required.

**EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN:** At check-in you will receive your run number. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

Judges **WILL** be flexible with evaluations and accommodate conflicts.

Virtual Rally and Virtual Agility **will not** be evaluated on-site and must be submitted to AKC for titles.

**Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.\* Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

#### DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

**From Portland:** Follow I-5 S to SW Wilsonville Rd in Wilsonville. Take exit 283 from I-5 S, Continue on SW Wilsonville Rd for approximately 4 miles. Turn right to SW Edminston Rd Drive for approximately 1 mile. Turn right to SW Ladd Hill Rd for approximately ¼ mile. Turn left to SW Heater Rd for approximately ¼ mile then turn left to NE Corral Creek Rd. Corral Creek Dog Sport Center will be approximately 2 ½ miles on your right.

**From Salem:** Follow I-5 N to exit 263 to Brooks/Gervais, turn left onto Brooklake Rd NE for approximately ¾ mile. Turn right to River Rd NE and follow for approximately 13 ½ miles. Turn left to McKay Rd NE, in approximately 2 miles, turn right to OR 219 N. In approximately 2 ½ miles Exit to Wilsonville Rd. Follow for approximately 2 miles and turn right to NE Renne Rd. Turn right to NE Corral Creek Rd in approximately ½ mile. Corral Creek Dog Sport Center will be approximately 1 ½ miles on your right.
